Description

SDF-1 α and β are stromal derived CXC chemokines, and signal through the CXCR4 receptor. SDF-1 α and β chemoattract B and T cells, and have been shown to induce migration of CD34+ stem cells. Additionally, the SDF-1 proteins exert HIV suppressive activity in cells expressing the CXCR4 receptor. Recombinant human SDF-1 β is an 8.5 kDa protein containing 72 amino acid residues.

BiologicalActivity

Determined by its ability to chemoattract human peripheral T cells activated with PHA and IL-2 using a concentration range of 20-80 ng/ml.

Authenticity

Verified by N-terminal and Mass Spectrometry analyses (when applicable).

Endotoxin Endotoxin level is <0.1 ng/ μg of protein (<1EU/ μg).

Protein Content

Verified by UV Spectroscopy and/or SDS-PAGE gel.
